Learners review types of departments that are supported by logistics, core functions, typical workflows, key activity triggers, and the overall impacts of logistics to a healthcare organization.

E-Learning course that explains staging, delivery, putaway, and storage within the healthcare supply chain and its importance to efficient operations and patients. Learners review delivery modes, storage types and locations, controlled versus non-controlled requirements, item placement decisions, and the technologies used to confirm accurate putaway and storage.
