RDA has many years of experience with standardizing and streamlining the Procedural Supply Chain.

#### Issue

- Inconsistent and redundant processes for managing medsurg supplies and case pick
- Ineffective oversight of materials staff
- Significant case pick returns backlog

#### **Resolution / Outcome**

- Reduced returns processing from 72 to 12 hours
- Established best practices and created 25+ Standard Work Instructions by functional activity
- Documented consolidated process opportunities improving service and reducing FTE requirements by 30%
- Optimized inventory levels in sterile core reducing inventory and improving fill rate on case pick
